Mohammad Foyez Ullah of Dhaka, Bangladesh is a man who is at the pinnacle of architectural professionalism in his own country. His architecture is recognizable for their pure and austere qualities and notable for their dignity and restraints. Well over a quarter century into the profession, his style has largely been accepted as a philosophy that responds to the socio-economic and tropical context of Dhaka.

Academically he was quite meritorious. He earned a distinction for his BArch and the "Ahsanur Rahman Gold Medal" for his Masters from Bangladesh University of Engineering & Technology, BUET. Soon after graduation in 1993, he started his career as an educator and taught as an Assistant Professor at the Department of Architecture, BUET until 1998. Throughout his career as an educator, he has inspired students around BRAC University, University of Asia Pacific, North South University and BUET. Concurrently, a successful legacy in the professional field was also initiated when he co-founded Vistaara Architects in 1994. After leaving BUET in 1998, Foyez concentrated more on the practice and his noteworthy contributions are GP House, Bashundhara City, UTC, The Westin, PICL Bhaban, Shanta Western Tower and many more diverse building typologies. It was predominantly the expressive nature of his architecture that bought him prominence and inspired a generation to aspire a career in the field.

Award and accolades for Foyez include the highest design accreditation like IAB Design Award, Holcim Green Built Award, Berger Excellence in Architecture Award, etc. After regenerating his practice through Volumezero Ltd in 2008, acclaimed projects that include the first ever LEED gold certified commercial buildings in Bangladesh, such as Simpletree Anarkali, Shahjalal Bank CHQ, Lighthouse and other notable works like ICCB, Akij House, Ispahani Housing among many consolidates his leadership in architecture and sustainably principled design. He kept himself relevant in academia by publishing critical articles, scholarly papers and write ups through various institutions and media. While as a juror for countless architectural competitions he continues to contribute towards the profession and appreciation for architecture in its quintessential form. Through his practice at Volumezero, Foyez raises the bar of what is possible and invariably achievable. Through established examples he validates the belief that - architecture we conceive and establish eventually end up building us.
